Effective January 1, 2003 the members of Borough Council expanded the newsprint recycling program to include not only newsprint but also magazines, catalogs, junk mail, telephone books, note books, and school papers (including spiral bound books) soft and hard back books and text books, shopping and pet food bags (without plastic liners), chipboard packaging, beer and soda cartons, cracker, cake, cereal boxes (without plastic pouches or insert) and corrugated boxes. **NO PIZZA BOXES.** These items are now referred to as "MIXED PAPER" collected curbside each Monday and designated by M on this calendar. MIXED PAPER must be tied and placed in brown Kraft-type paper bags and corrugated boxes must be flattened and securely tied together with string. **INDIVIDUALS NOT SEPARATING "MIX PAPER" FROM THEIR TRASH MAY FIND THAT THEIR TRASH MAY BE DEEMED UNCOLLECTIBLE.** Your cooperation in this program is appreciated. The program helps to save the environment and to save our tax dollars.
